Our diverse and engaging sessions are designed to be both targeted and comprehensive, providing valuable insights and practical knowledge.

The E2 Team has successfully established a positive rapport with both learners and staff members at the college, including tutors and fellow support staff. This achievement is largely attributed to our strategically located Hub in the centre of the college.
